



Road traffic medicine – alcohol and drug issues

Professor Wall is the Academic Dean and a past President of the Faculty of Forensic and Legal Medicine (FFLM) and was the final President of the Association of Forensic Physicians and a former President of the Clinical Forensic and Legal Medicine Section of the Royal Society of Medicine. He was the first David Jenkins Professor of Forensic and Legal Medicine, was the FFLM lead on credentialing and has an academic honorary appointment as Visiting Professor at Teesside University.

He undertakes the whole range of clinical forensic medicine and is a contributing author to several textbooks including *Clinical Forensic Medicine - A Physician's Guide* and *Clinical Forensic Medicine* writing the chapters on drink and drug driving.
